Since the time of the last General Assembly of ISEBTT (September 2017, Norfolk, VA, USA), the Society's presence online is being represented by a new, completely redesigned, and continuously upgraded website that is available at www.electroporation.net.

The old site, whose set-up and development were made possible through funding procured from the European Commission-backed networking project COST TD1104 – EP4Bio²Med, was thus ultimately retired last September, about a year and a half after the COST Action ended, and has served us well for five years since its launch in September 2012. It will continue to permanently serve its purpose of informing visitors of the activities carried out within the scope of the Action, although it has been relocated to a different web address (now to be found at cost.electroporation.net).

In addition to new, current postings, the new electroporation.net website will eventually feature an archive of past announcements, news, events, and publications that you were used to finding on the old (COST) website, but for the moment, it is entirely dedicated to the formation and functioning of the Society. We intend to continue publishing news, announcements, events and publications related to the subject of electroporation and pulsed electric fields on the new electroporation.net, and would like to solicit **your** help in developing the official website of our Society into a truly useful and comprehensive resource for all members, visitors, and in general all interested parties to benefit from.

The information you can **already** find on the site pertains to the formation and functioning of the Society; there you will find info on the [Council members](#), founding [Documents](#) (bylaws, articles of incorporation, etc.), an archive of [Newsletters](#), and of course materials and benefits available only to the members of ISEBTT – the online access to the [Handbook of Electroporation](#) (read [instructions](#) on how to access), as well as the Members' [Documents Repository](#), where you will find minutes and materials from the Council and General Assembly meetings.
