We are approaching the 5th World Congress on Electroporation (WCE 2024), scheduled to take place in Rome, and we are delighted to share with you the latest updates.

The abstract submission process has been concluded, and we received more than 350 abstracts, which have been completely reviewed. Abstracts were assigned to sessions, and notifications have been sent to all presenters. Overall, the program turned out to be extremely rich and interesting.

Several new initiatives have been introduced in the 5th WCE. One example is the Industry Panel, an event dedicated to gather industry, academia, and regulatory bodies, which will be focused for this first time into the applications of electric pulses for cardiac ablation (PFA). Don't miss it!

There will be a dedicated program for Young Scientists (PhD students and early career researchers), including a 3MT (Three Minute Thesis) competition exclusively for PhD students. The deadline has been extended (July 5th), so hurry and sign up! There will be a special social event for young scientists in a magnificent and cool location close to the venue with music and food. All young scientists are invited, after the sessions, at the beer corner in the cloister of the Faculty!

Thanks to the donation of Doreen J. Putrah Cancer Research Foundation, numerous travel grants will be given to student and early career researchers.

We welcome all attendees to the Ceremony on Sunday afternoon in the Basilica of San Pietro in Vincoli, which also hosts the marvelous Michelangelo statue of Moses. There will be greetings and welcome speeches from local authorities and the ISEBTT president, followed by a string concert.

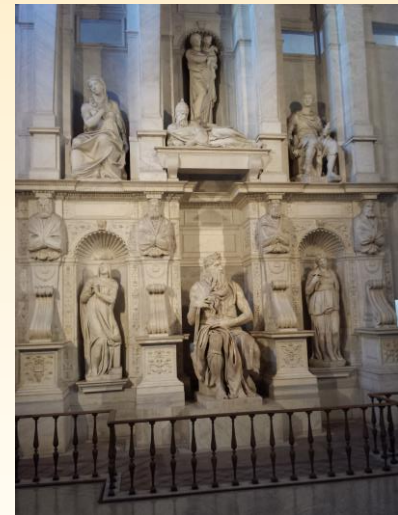
